

KIRK IN TRANSLATION

In a world ruled by ideology and a fearsome relativism, the contributions of authors like

G. K. Chesterton or T. S. Eliot can often be better understood now than during their own time. The same can be said of Russell Kirk, who taught the permanent things to America for a half century and now his ideas are also flourishing in other countries.

This renewed interest can be seen in the growing number of academic papers, dissertations and doctoral theses on

Kirk, as well as the translations of his articles and books into a wide variety of foreign countries and languages. Kirk's Conservative Mind has been published in Czech, German, and Spanish. Other works published include: Spain A Program for Conservatives and Edmund Burke; Italy, The Roots of American Order, and The Politics of Prudence; Poland, Prospects for Conservatives; South Korea, Academic Freedom; and Holland Old House of Fear.

Soon, É Realizações, a Brazilian publishing house, will be launching four titles in Portuguese: Eliot and His Age, The Politics of Prudence, Edmund Burke, and The Conservative Mind.

Articles by and about Kirk have translated into Bulgarian, German, Italian, Norwegian, Polish, and Russian, Portuguese and Japanese.

For over forty years Kirk reminded his readers that "The malady of

normative decay gnaws at order in the person and at order in the republic. Until we recognize the nature of these afflictions, we must sink ever deeper into the disorder of the soul and the disorder of the state. A recovery of norms can be commenced only when we moderns come to understand in what manner we have fallen away from old truths." Rediscover the old truths-this is Russell Kirk's message to the whole world.
